

Pyrolysis is a folk band with mostly acoustic, traditional, instruments, but with the mindset of a punk-rock band. We play fast-paced energetic music, barefooted.

- We understand that this stage plan is a best-world-scenario. Please feel free to contact us by mail or phone if you have any questions or if something is not possible. We can make almost anything work!
- We strongly prefer a talk-back option from FoH to our monitors.
- We always bring: our own 'DIs' for the mandolin and bass; a wireless headset for Stan (xlr out); wireless systems for accordion (xlr out) and violin (we bring our own DI, xlr out); mic for the bodhran (Irish frame drum); small pedal-boards for the bouzouki and mandolin; enough jack-jack cables; spare batteries.
- We need a mixer with plate & hall reverb, compression, and gate for all channels
- The bouzouki amp acts as a DI for the Irish bouzouki.
- In total we need 6 power supplies in the back, and at least 2 in the front.
- We also bring our back-drop-banner (3x2m) and would like to hang it behind us, bring 3 fluffy carpets for on stage, and some small stage decoration, if allowed.
